



## SC Productions General Rules



- ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR RUN
- Arriving at event facility before 7:00 AM Friday will result in an early arrival fee \$20 per horse \$25 Electrical
- A \$25.00 return check fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.
- All contestants must have a current W9 form for the current year on file to receive a check. Checks are valid for 90 days. Any checks that need to be re-issued will be charged a \$25 Fee. Any checks not cashed within the 90 days (as printed on the checks) will be considered void and will not be re-issued for any reason.
- Early Arrivals:
  - Contestants can come anytime **AFTER 5pm** on Thursday with a early arrival fee \$20 per horse \$25 for electrical. Early Arrivals are anyone on the grounds before 7am Friday morning. Absolutely, no one on the grounds before 5pm Thursday for any reason
- **NO REFUNDS** after pre-entry deadline for any REASON.
- By entering you agree to abide by and follow all rules and are responsible for any horse you bring to this event and will be considered an agent for such horse. We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
- SC Productions have the final say on all rulings.

### **Horse OR Rider Substitutions Rule:**

**Revised JULY 1, 2020:**

**Horse and/or Rider Substitutions / buying spots are allowed in the event a horse or rider gets hurt during the time Pre-Entries Close and the start of said event.**

- Refunds will be granted for any reason prior to the pre entry date. Less office fee
- No refunds for any reason after the Close of the Pre-Entry Date for said event
- Changes must be submitted on an Official Horse/Rider Change form in the show office
- Horse/Rider Substitutions Close at:
  - Friday at 4:00 PM
  - Saturday 10:00 AM
  - Sunday's Race must be done by 8pm Saturday night.
- **\$5 change Fee PER DAY/PER CHANGE.**
  - FOR EXAMPLE) If you change Friday, Saturday & Sunday Open Classes it's \$5 per day/per change = \$15.00
  - If you're changing youth spots on top of the open that's an additional \$5 per change/per day
- Side Pots can NOT be sold
- No changes on Sunday morning for any reason. Changes associated with buying a spot cannot be made by email, text or face book.
- ALL CHANGES must be made in the show office.
- The NEW RIDER will pay the office fee to the show office and the change fees.
- New Riders must sign release form in the show office
- Futurity/Derby changes - see Futurity Derby Rules Rules

This change has been put into place to the overwhelming amount of changes. Over the past year we are doing over 200 changes per event. This accommodation has been getting out of control and we have decided in order for us to host a faster, smoother & less chance for errors in the draw we had to make changes in order for us to do a better job hosting an event that you will enjoy to attend. In order for our staff to get the changes

and late entries put into the computer, printed for the contestants and copies to the announcer, timer & gate officials on time BEFORE the start of the race. We had to come up with a new plan for changes. No one wants to see errors in the draw or payouts. We had to make these hard business changes in order for SC Productions to produce better events for the contestants

**Dress Code:** Contestants must wear western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine) Hat/helmets optional

### **Competition Rules**

- Rerun will be given to those horses that ran with a barrel off set on the marker or incase the timer fails. All reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director
- We will drag after every 5 riders, big drag every 50 riders
- A horse may enter each race only once.
- Tipped barrel results in as a no time
- The three-call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified.
- Only the next 10 riders may be in the warm up arena prior to your run. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH GATE OFFICIAL THEMSELVES PRIOR TO RUNNING OR THEY MAY BE SUBJECT TO Disqualification. If you have a safety issues, please talk to the gateman so that we can work with you PRIOR to making your run. NO TAKING TACK OFF IN THE WARM UP PEN AFTER YOUR RUN!
- No Running out of draw order. No switching of draw positions. HORSE MUST RUN IN POSITIONS DRAWN! – Disqualification
- No letting horses roll or lounging horses in warm up arena during the barrel race, warm ups or exhibitions.
- Pre-Draw will be posted on SCProductionsLLC.com/Draw Page
- Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena if not followed by a \$50.00 fine will be assessed.
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run
- Riders MUST maintain forward motion! Disqualification

### **Late Entries**

- Are accepted, whether you are entering for 1 day or all 3 days. Late Entries close at draw #50 in each Open class

### **Exhibitions/Warm Ups:**

- Friday Warm Ups and Exhibitions will be sold on SC Productions Website. Saturday's will go on sale in the show office Friday night and Sundays will go on sale in the show office Saturday night. CASH ONLY for SAT & SUN
- No ponying horses in 30 min warm ups
- Exhibitions will be 60 seconds, 1 trip through, Limited number sold each day.

### **Facility Rules:**

- All horses must be placed in a stall belonging to the arena.
- One horse per stall. No portable pens. No tying horses outside overnight – results in disqualification
- All bedding must be purchased through the event facility. No outside shavings or straw allowed! \$50 fines will apply
- Everyone will be photographed at these events and videoed.
- NO DOGS IN THE SHOW ARENA DURING THE BARREL RACING COMPETATION.

**Payout Back Scale:** 75% Entry fees, 100% Added money, No Time for tipped barrel

**Open Class** 5D Format, Half second split. –

**Youth Class** 4D Format, half second split. Youth 18 & Under, as of Jan 1<sup>st</sup>

Youth contestants that wish to enter same horse in the Open the same day MUST carry over. (CAN NOT RUN TWICE)

**Senior Side Pot** 4D Format, half second splits. As of Jan 1<sup>st</sup>. Open to anyone 50 & over. You must enter the open class to carry your time.

**Open Futurity & Derby Side Pot:** 2D Format, Futurity full second split. Open to horses 5 years old and under. The horse cannot have been competed Dec prior year. All futurity horses must be registered. Copy of horse's registration papers. Derby 2D format, half sec split, horses not eligible for futurity

**SIDE POT:** Any Changes or corrections to side pot entries must be made before the end of that race. Once results are posted for side pot ..... changes will not be made to the results. Results posted are FINAL. Please double check to make sure you listed in all side pots you entered. No selling side pots

**Vendors:**

- All vendors must have approval to sell a product or provide a service at any SC Productions Events. Vendors will receive advertising during event with approval
