

SC Productions General Rules



- ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR RUN
- A \$25.00 return check fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.
- All contestants must have a <u>current W9 form</u> for the current year on file to receive a check. <u>Checks are valid for</u> 90 days.
- Early Arrivals:
 - Contestants can come anytime <u>AFTER 5:00pm</u> on Thursday with a early arrival fee \$20 per horse \$25 for electrical. Early Arrivals are anyone on the grounds before 7:00am Friday morning. Absolutely, no one on the grounds before 5pm Thursday for any reason
- NO REFUNDS For any reason.. you can sell your spots less the office fee
- By entering you agree to abide by and follow all rules and are responsible for any horse you bring to this event and will be considered an agent for such horse. We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
- SC Productions have the final say on all rulings.

Horse OR Rider Substitutions Rule:

Horse and/or Rider Substitutions / buying spots are allowed in the event a horse or rider gets hurt during the time Pre-Entries Close and the start of said event.

• No refunds for any reason - selling spots is an option

CHANGES:

- Changes must be submitted on an Official Horse/Rider Change form in the show office.
- Horse/Rider Substitutions Close at:
 - Friday at 4:00 PM change for Youth and Open Classes
 - Saturday 10:00 AM changes for Youth and Open Classes
 - Sunday's Classes must be done by 6:00 pm Saturday night. For Youth and Open Classes
 - May July August Futurity/Derby Late entries and changes close Friday before event at 8:00pm. \$50 fee will apply for late entries and or changes

CHANGES For the June Event are different due to the Schedule of event starting earlier.

- Youth & Open Classes Changes Close Friday & Saturday 10:00 AM
- Youth & Open Classes Changes Close Saturday at 6:00PM for Sunday Changes
- Late Entries and Changes for the MN Futurity Maturity Close Thursday, 8:00P
- \$5 change Fee PER DAY/PER CHANGE.
 - FOR EXAMPLE) If you change Friday, Saturday & Sunday Open Classes it's \$5 per day/per change = \$15.00
- Side Pots can NOT be sold.
- No changes on Sunday morning for any reason. Changes associated with buying a spot cannot be made by email, text or face book.
- ALL CHANGES must be made in the show office.
- The NEW RIDER will pay the office fee to the show office and the change fees.
- New Riders must sign the release form in the show office.

<u>Dress Code Pee Wee, Youth & Open Classes</u>: Contestants must wear western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine) Hat/helmets optional.

<u>Dress Code for Futurity/Derby/Maturity classes</u> Hats and or helmets are required. Not following dress code rules will result in disqualification for that go round.

Competition Rules

- SC Productions reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason
- Reruns will be given to those horses that ran with a barrel off set on the marker or in case the timer fails. All
 reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director
- We will drag after every 5 riders, big drag every 50 riders.
- A horse may enter each race only once.
- Cordless eyes will be used. New batteries will be placed in the timer prior to the start of each go-round. In the event of a timer malfunction, rider will get a rerun option.
- Tipped barrel results in as a no time.
- The three-call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified for that run.
- Only the next 10 riders may be in the warmup arena prior to your run. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH
 GATE OFFICIAL as they enter the holding pen. If you have safety issues, please talk to the gateman so that we
 can work with you PRIOR to making your run.
- No Running out of draw order. No switching of draw positions. HORSE MUST RUN IN POSITIONS DRAWN! this will result in a Disqualification
- No letting horses roll or lounging horses in warm up arena during the barrel race, warm ups or exhibitions.
- Pre-Draw will be posted on SCProductionsLLC.com/Draw Page
- Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena if not followed by a \$50.00 fine will be accessed.
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
- Riders MUST maintain forward motion! Disqualification

Late Entries

 Are accepted until the last horse runs in the class. Late draw will be post at Draw 50 in the open – entries after draw 50 will be put on the end of the class

Exhibitions/Warm Ups:

- Friday Warmups and Exhibitions will be sold on SC Productions Website. Saturday's will go on sale in the show
 office Friday night and Sundays will go on sale in the show office Saturday night. CASH ONLY for SAT & SUN
- No ponying horses in 30 min warmups
- Exhibitions will be 60 seconds; Limited number sold each day Over 60 seconds will be assessed a \$10 penalty. To be paid before you run.

Facility Rules:

- All horses must be placed in a stall belonging to the arena.
- One horse per stall. No portable pens. No tying horses outside overnight results in disqualification.
- All bedding must be purchased through the event facility. No outside shavings or straw allowed!
- Everyone will be photographed at these events and videoed.
- NO DOGS IN THE SHOW ARENA DURING THE BARREL RACING COMPETATION.

Payout Back Scale: 75% Entry fees, 100% Added money, No Time for tipped barrel.

Open Class 5D Format, Half second split.

Youth Class 4D Format, half second split. Youth 18 & Under, as of Jan 1st

Youth contestants entered in both the Open and the Youth Class the Youth time will carry to the Open. (CAN NOT RUN TWICE)

<u>Pee Wee Classes</u> – Straight pay – 10 & Under as of Jan 1^{st} . No late fees for the Pee Wee. Cash Winnings can be picked up in the show office. SC Productions will not mail Cash

Pole Bending: 3D Format, Full Second Splits, 75% entry fee paid out, 100% added money paid out, Tipped pole – No time

<u>Senior Side Pot</u> 4D Format, half second splits. As of day of event. Open to anyone 50 & over. You must enter the open class to carry your time. No late fee to add a side pot to your entry.

<u>Open Futurity & Derby Side Pot:</u> 2D Format, Futurity full second split. Open to horses 4 & 5 years old. The horse cannot have been competed Nov 15th prior year. All futurity horses must be registered. Derby open to 7 & Under - 2D format, half sec split, horses not eligible for futurity. Copy of horse registration papers required at the time you enter.

<u>SIDE POT:</u> Any Changes or corrections to side pot entries must be made before you run. It's the responsibility of the rider to check their carryover entry and notify the office of any missed entry. Once results are posted for side pot changes will not be made to the results. Results posted are FINAL. Please double check to make sure you listed in all side pots you entered. No selling side pots classes. No late fees to add a side pot

Futurity/Derby Classes: Registration papers Required when entering a Futurity and Derby EVERY EVENT

Open Futurity – 2D Format, Full Second Splits, Open to 4 and 5 year olds. Horse must never have entered a barrel race prior to November 15th the prior year. To do so means to forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Exhibitions or "time Only" runs prior to November 15th are allowed.

Open Derby – 2D Format, half second splits, Open to 7 & Under horses. (5-year-olds can be compete in the futurity and derby)

- All Futurity/Derby horses entered must be checked in and numbered before they run. Check the event schedule for times to get your horses checked in. Time set are the ONLY times available to get checked in
- Futurity/Derby Late entries and changes close Friday before event at 8:00pm. \$50 fee will apply for late entries and or changes
- 2nd go reverse order
- Late Entries run last in the 1st Go round and First in the 2nd Go round
- Awards to the 1D & 2D Fastest Average times

Vendors:

- All vendors must have approval to sell a product or provide a service at any SC Productions Events. Vendors will receive advertising during the event with approval.

- Selling products (NEW OR USED) or providing a service on the MEC or Double F, grounds without a vendor approval from Casey. This will result in disqualification for all parties involved.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables and chairs.
- SC Productions or event facility are NOT responsible for your vendor booth or products or service while you are attending SC Productions events.
