Minnesota Breeders Futurity & Maturity



The Minnesota Futurity is held with the Cowgirl Tuff Open Barrel Race. Contestants can enter the Open Futurity/Maturity Classes and a Breeders Side Pot Futurity/Maturity for horses BY current enrolled stallions.

The Minnesota Stallion Incentive program is a great way to advertise and promote your stallion. Each stallion is nominated for a fee of \$425.00. All eligible stallions can be previewed on our website at www.SCProductionsllc.com/MN Futurity Page. Stallion Enrollments Close March 1 2025

Stallion Benefits

Stallions enrolled in the Minnesota Futurity Program will be promoted on SCProductionsLLC.com website, face book, Minnesota Futurity Event Program & all SC Productions Event programs and printed color programs at the event. SC Productions will have custom stallion signage on display at all SC Productions Events.

Stallion Payouts

Money collected from the stallion nominations will pay out 100% at the Minnesota Futurity Breeder's Futurity and Maturity. Minnesota Futurity pays back 20% to stallion owners placing in 1st go, 2nd go and/or average & 20% to Minnesota Futurity for advertising, website, social media advertising, administration, awards, marketing signage and stallion promotions. Custom awards for Open & Breeders Finalist 1D & 2D winners. 100% of all Stallion money will be paid out EACH YEAR.

Entries are checked for eligibility to compete in the breeders' incentive side pot. All foals by the nominated stallions will be eligible. Stallion owners must nominate on an annual basis in order for foals to be eligible. The **incentive fund** is an additional side pot of money for entries that are sired by the nominated stallions or the stallion himself.

Open Futurity:

- \$3,000 Added Money
- 2D Full Second split
- 4 and 5 year old horses. – Age of horse is determined by Jan 1 "birthday"
- Copy of Registration Papers are required at the time you enter
- 2 Rounds – Friday & Saturday
- Must be entered in the Open 5D Classes Each day – Futurity Times carry over to the Open Class each day
- Full Second Splits
- Horse(s) must never have entered a barrel race ever (open shows, rodeos, jackpots, futurities, etc) prior to November 15th, 2024. To do so means to forfeit any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Exhibition or "time only" runs prior to November 15th are allowed.
- NO REFUNDS

Open Maturity:

- * \$2,000 Added Money
- * 2D Format – ½ second split
- * 8 & Under – horses entered in the futurity can NOT enter the Maturity
- * Open to Any Aged horse by incentive stallions or the stallion himself
- * Horses that have competed in the Minnesota Futurity and/or Maturity, are eligible for life to enter
- * Copy of Registration Papers are required at the time you enter
- * 2 Rounds – Friday & Saturday
- * Must be entered in the Friday and Saturday Open 5D Classes. Maturity time carries over to the Open each day
- * NO REFUNDS

Breeders Side Pots: are for horses BY current enrolled stallions. Contestants need to be entered in the Open Futurity and/or Open Maturity classes to enter the Breeders Side Pots. 100% of Breeders Entry Fee is paid back to the contestant

Current Coggins are required.

All fees, early arrivals, Stalls, RV, Entries ect must be paid before you run. \$25 fines will apply to fees not paid before you run.

Horse/rider Changes:

- Changes Close Thursday 8:00PM the night. \$50.00 change fee for substitutions of horse or rider.

Late Entries:

Close at 8:00 PM, Thursday before said event. Late fee of \$50 applies at event to enter.

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE LAST FOR THE FIRST GO and FIRST FOR THE SECOND GO.

Futurity Payout

Breeders Futurity is a 2D format, full second split. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Open Futurity is a 2D format, full second split. 75% of entry fees along with 100% of the added money. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

*Upon the result of a tie, money will be added together and split evenly for payback.

Maturity Payout

Breeders Maturity is a 2D format, half second split. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Open Maturity is a 2D format, half second split. Payout 75% of entry fees along with 100% of the added money. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Awards

Open Futurity & Maturity Awards to the Top 3 - 1D & 2D to the fastest average winners

Breeders Futurity & Maturity Awards to the Top 3 - 1D & 2D to the fastest average winners

- In case, of a tie, awards will be given out according to fastest individual time.
- Awards need to be picked up at the event. No awards will be mailed or brought to another event.

***Stallion Incentive Purse** – 20% of Stallion Breeders Incentive. Payout will be based on entries placing in the 1D each Go &/or Average in both the Futurity and Maturity. All Stallions will have to renew their enrollment annually each year. 100% of all Stallion money will be paid out EACH YEAR.

Race Rules

- A maximum of three gate calls will be made, if contestant can't make the run in 3 gate calls, results in disqualified for that go-round.
- Tipped barrel will result in a No Time
- 2nd Go is in Reverse Order.
- Futurity/Maturity Entries are required to Enter and carry over to the Open 5D each day.
- All horses entered in this event will have to have a stall or pay a tie out fee – Facility Rules
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
- Contestants are not allowed to sell products new or used or provide a service at any SC Productions Events – this action will result in disqualification of all parties involved.
- Rider must maintain forward motion – results in disqualification for that go-round.
- Running out of draw order is – Results in Disqualification
- * Cordless eye will be used. New batteries will be placed in the timer prior to the start of each go-round.
- * Should the timer fail, contestant will get a rerun option.

- * All Fees must be paid prior to your run – If contestants fee's not paid BEFORE they run \$25 Fines will apply.
- * Missed payment results in a \$50 late fee
- * W9 Forms must be on file for checks to be released
- * No Refunds will be given for any reason

Dress Code: Western boots, long sleeve shirt and hat/or Helmet are required in the futurity & maturity classes. Long sleeve shirts with no collars are allowed. Out of dress code will result in disqualification for that go.

- Any disputes or questions that arise during the event which are not covered by the above rules will be determined by
