Entry Rules:

- Riders can enter this event on: Saddlebook.com
 - Stalls, RV, Exhibitions, Warmups can be purchased on SC Productions JotForm – This link can be found on SCProductionsllc.com (Doing it this way will help save contestant saddlebook fees)



Stalling/Shavings/Jump Outs:

Event facilities require you to purchase a stall in order to be on the grounds overnight. FAILURE to follow this rule will result in DQ (without a refund) Horses coming for the day that don't need a stall will need to pay a tie out fee \$20 per horse / per day. Every horse on the grounds needs to have a stall or pay a tie out. Not following this rule will result in DQ without a refund.

To streamline the entry process and ensure everyone gets appropriately matched stalls, every contestant must fill out a Stall Form.

(1) FORM PER RIDER - DO NOT BUY STALLS FOR OTHER RIDERS

Stall forms helps us easily coordinate stall assignments with your race entries.

Why Order Stalls Through Our Jotform?

Cheaper for You:

- Stalls
 - Shavings
 - Tie Outs
- By purchasing stalls, shavings, and tie outs through our Jotform (and *not* Saddle Book), you benefit from significantly lower prices. We are trying to make it as cheap as possible for our contestants to enter our races, and avoid raising entry fees through the saddle book system.

If we experience problems with this system and high race volumes overwhelm stall availability, we may need to transition stall sales to Saddle Book. This would, unfortunately, increase the overall cost of entering races for everyone. Please avoid a fee increase by ordering stalls through the jotform before the due date!

After May 22, 2026:

All stall/jumpout purchases **must** be made with a credit card. Credit card processing fees will apply to all transactions after the deadline.

Your cooperation in ordering stalls through the Jotform and adhering to the deadline helps us

- **Stalls and Tie out fees for horses entered must be done at the same time you enter the show**
- Stalls come with 2 bags of shavings. If you want extra shavings pre delivered, you can order them on the JotForm. This will only be for PRE ENTRIES. After we close pre-entries additional shavings can be purchased in the show office.
- **Stalls:** \$75 flat rate Fri-Sun comes with 2 bags of shavings. \$25 Early Stall fee coming in on Thursday after 5:00pm: NO overnight ties out or building pens
- **Hookups:** \$75 Fri-Sun weekend rate. Thursday – Sunday \$110
- **Shavings:** Extra shavings can be purchased on the pre-stall jot form. Or in the show office
 - \$10.00 per bag

Pre Entries – close Sunday at 11:59pm prior to event

- Pre Draw will be posted by 11:59pm Wednesday prior to event
- **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR RUN - \$25 fines will apply**
- \$35.00 return check fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.

Late entries:

- Riders can enter the event after we post the pre draw by logging into Saddlebook.com
- Late fee will apply: \$15.00 per rider/per weekend
- All late entries will be posted each day at the event
- Late Entries are CASH, CHECK or Credit Card ONLY at the event.

Refunds: We'll refund entries through pre-entry deadline (Sunday 11:59pm prior to event) 70% of entries (less convenience fees)

- After the Pre Entry deadline – NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON

Selling Spots: Riders can sell their spots

- if you sell your spot you lose your office fee and the new rider will pay an office fee (unless they already paid the office fee) New rider will need to do a change form in the show office
- **NO CHANGES MADE VIA EMAIL, PHONE, TEXT or FACEBOOK MESSAGE**
- Change fees apply – find change date and time deadline for each event
- Side Pots can only be sold if its sold with the open spot. No selling side pots separate

- If selling a futurity derby spot the new horse will be required to have a copy of the registration papers. Be sure to bring a copy with you to the office. We will not take papers texted, or emailed. **MUST HAVE A COPY TO LEAVE IN THE OFFICE TO ENTER!**

Early Arrivals:

- Facility Gate will Open at **5:00pm** on Thursday. – **NO ARRIVALS BEFORE 5:00 PM FOR ANY REASON**
- Early arrival fee \$25 per horse \$35 for electrical. Early Arrivals are anyone on the grounds before 7:00am Friday morning. Absolutely, no one on the grounds before 5pm Thursday for any reason

Horse OR Rider Substitutions Rule:

- Changes must be submitted on an Official Horse/Rider Change form in the show office.
- \$5.00 Per day/per change will apply
- Horse/Rider Substitutions Close at:
 - Friday at 4:00 PM – change for Youth and Open Classes
 - Saturday 10:00 AM – changes for Youth and Open Classes
 - Sunday's Classes must be done by 6:00 pm Saturday night. – For Youth and Open Classes
- The NEW RIDER required to pay an office fee
- Futurity Derby Changes and Late Entries Close Friday Night 7:00pm (onsite)

Dress Code Pee Wee, Youth & Open Classes:

- Western boots
- Long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine)
- Hat/Helmets optional. – Futurity, Derby Maturity Classes – Hats/Hemet required
- Not following dress code - Will results in Disqualification
- **New Hat Rule for 2026:** if you lose your hat in the arena or alley way you'll be fined \$5.00.
 - **REQUIRED: To Pay the barrel setter Cash to get your hat.**

Coggins/Health:

- Contestants can Drop off coggins in the basket on the desk marked Coggins in the show office.
 - Note: By law, horses out of state are always required to have a health papers

Competition Rules

- By entering you agree to abide by and follow all rules set by SC Productions
- We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
- SC Productions have the final say on all rulings.
- Reruns will be given to those horses that ran with a barrel off set on the marker or in case the timer fails. All reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director
- We will drag after every 5 riders, big drag every 50 riders.
- A horse may enter each race only once.
- Cordless eyes will be used. New batteries will be placed in the timer prior to the start of each go-round. In the event of a timer malfunction, rider will get a rerun option.
- Tipped barrel results in as a no time.

- The three-call rule will be used and enforced. We reserve the right to scratch a contestant for failing to begin their run after 3 gate calls or the 3 minutes time has elapsed! This will result in a NO TIME for that run.
- Only the next 10 riders may be in the warmup arena prior to your run. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH GATE OFFICIAL as they enter the holding pen. If you have safety issues, please talk to the gateman so that we can work with you PRIOR to making your run.
- No Running out of draw order. No switching of draw positions. HORSE MUST RUN IN POSITIONS DRAWN! – this will result in a Disqualification
- Failure to be present for a competition run will result in a scratch! In the event of a missed run, contestants will have the option to be added back in to the race at the end by paying a second entry fee!
- No letting horses roll or lounging horses in warm up arena during the barrel race, warm ups or exhibitions.
- Pre-Draw will be posted on SCProductionsLLC.com and on Saddlebook.com
- Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena if not followed by a \$50.00 fine will be assessed.
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
- Riders MUST maintain forward motion! Disqualification
- Are accepted until the last horse runs in the class. Late draw will be post at Draw 50 in the open – entries after draw 50 will be put on the end of the class

Picking Up Winnings:

- W9 must be submitted before collecting any winnings. **NO WINNINGS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THESE FORMS ARE ON FILE FOR THE CURRENT TAX YEAR**
- Checks must be cashed within 30 days: We will no longer re-issue checks after 30 days after date issued. Checks not cashed 30 days after issue date or checks that aren't picked up (due to w9 not being turned in) will be voided after 30 days and monies put back into the awards fund. Please make sure you have a current w9 on file

Exhibitions/Warm Ups:

- Friday Warmups and Exhibitions will be sold on SC Productions Website.
- Saturday Exhibitions will go on sale in the show office Friday night see event schedule
- Exhibitions will be 60 seconds; Limited number sold each day – Over 60 seconds will be assessed a \$10 penalty. To be paid before you run.
- Riders will have time spot options when they want to purchase Warm Ups and Exhibitions – first come first serve. Limited number sold each hour. Riders that miss the time spots they purchased for their Warm up or Exhibition will lose that spot without a Refund!

Facility Rules:

- All horses overnight must be placed in a stall belonging to the arena.
- One horse per stall. No portable pens. No tying horses outside overnight – results in disqualification
- No outside shavings or straw allowed!
- NO DOGS IN THE SHOW ARENA DURING THE BARREL RACING COMPETATION. We love dogs, but this is a requirement from our liability insurance company, and it will be enforced! All dogs on the property need to always be on a leash!

Vendors:

- Selling products (NEW OR USED) or providing a service on the MEC or Double F, grounds without approval from Casey. This will result in disqualification for all parties involved.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables and chairs.
- SC Productions or event facility are NOT responsible for your vendor booth or products or service while you are attending SC Productions events.

HAT FINES:

- **New Hat Rule for 2026:** if you lose your hat in the arena or alley way you’ll be fined \$5.00. Pay the barrel setter Cash to get your hat.

- 10 & Under as of day of event.
- **“NEW RULE” if entered in the Youth and/or Open class can not enter the Pee Wee Class**
- No late fees for the Pee Wee
- Cash Winnings can be picked up in the show office. SC Productions will not mail Cash

Youth Class

- 4D Format
- \$500 Added Saturday and Sunday Class
- ½ second Splits
- Youth 18 & Under, as of Jan 1st
- Youth contestants entered in both the Open and the Youth Class, the Youth time will carry to the Open.
 - CAN NOT RUN TWICE

Open Class

- 5D Format
- \$1,000 Added Friday - \$2,000 Added Saturday - \$2,000 Added Sunday
- ½ second Splits

Senior Side Pot

- 4D Format,
- \$200 Added Each Day
- ½ second Splits
- 50 & over. As of day of event
- Must be enter the Open 5D class to carry your time to the side pot.
- No late fee to add a side pot to your entry
- No Refunds or selling a side pot entry
- Click on Senior Side Pot Flyer for more information

Average Side Pot

- 4D Format
- \$500 Added
- ½ second Splits
- 2 Run Average from the Saturday and Sunday Open 5D Classes
- No refunds or selling a side pot entry
- Click on Average Side Pot For more information

Off The Track Side Pot

- 2D Format
- ½ second Splits
- \$500 Added – Sponsored by: MQHRA
- Must be entered in the Sunday Open 5D Class
- Any horse that **has raced** on a race track is eligible to enter
- No Refunds or selling side pot
- Click on Off The Track Flyer for more details

Futurity/Derby Classes:

- Registration papers Required when entering a Futurity and Derby –
 - EVERY EVENT – please, send your registration papers. We do not keep your papers from show to show.
 - If you buy a Futurity Derby Spot you need to bring a COPY of your Registration papers with you to leave in the office with your change form – ENFORCED for 2026 – Riders can NOT email or text papers to the office. If you do not have a copy of the registration papers for the office you WILL NOT be able to enter!
 - Dress Code: Western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine).

Hats and or helmets are required. Not following dress code rules will result in disqualification for that go round.

- **Futurity**
 - 2D Format, Full Second Splits
 - \$3,000 Added + Awards – Must be present to receive awards
 - Open to 4 and 5 year olds.
 - WPRA Approved & NRF Tour Approved
 - Must roll time to the opens each day
 - 2nd Go Reverse order starting with the late entries
 - Horse must never have entered a barrel race prior to November 15th the prior year. To do so means to forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Exhibitions or “time Only” runs prior to November 15th are allowed.
 - No Refunds
 - Any Changes made to entry will incur a \$50 change fee
- **Derby**
 - 2D Format,
 - \$2,000 Added + Awards – Must be present to receive awards
 - ½ second Splits
 - Must roll times to the open each day
 - Open to 8 & Under horses. (5-year-olds can be compete in the futurity and derby)
 - WPRA Approved & NRF Tour Approved
 - 2nd Go Reverse Order starting with the Late Entries
 - No refunds
 - Any changes made to entry will incur a \$50 change fee

NRF Tour Bonus Incentive Side Pot:

- \$500 Added -50+ entries
- Eligible for ONLY NRF Nominated horses
- Enter on NRFTour.com
- Payout details can be found on NRFTour.com

The Rookie Incentive Side Pot:

- \$2,000 Added
- If your lifetime earnings are under \$50,000 you qualify! Check the equistat.com
- Nominate Yourself
- Enter the Rookie Incentive Side Pot
- Must be entered in the OPEN

SIDE POTS:

- No selling side pots classes
- No late fees to add a side pot
- No Refunds on side pots – Unless it's sold to same horse and rider with the Open that same day

Hi Stakes – Side Pot:

- \$4,000 Added
- Fastest time from the Sat and Sun Open
- ½ second splits – 4D Format
- Riders do NOT have to run both Opens but have to be entered

Triple Crown OPEN SLOT RACE:

- \$2,000 Added + Awards
- 2D Format
- ½ second splits
- Limited to 30 Entries
- \$250 Entry Fee
- Must enter Sat Open – Carry Slot Race to Open - Carry back to 1st go Futurity Derby

The Non Incentive Horse

- \$1,000 Added with 10 entries – Less than 10 entries \$500 Added
- Horses under the age of 5 are eligible for The Non Incentive (NIH) if sire is not enrolled for any barrel incentives at the time of enrollment
- Horses 5 and over not currently enrolled in the barrel horse stallion incentive are eligible for NIH.
- 1 Race over the 3 days
- You can enter each day to increase your chances
- Must be entered in the Open classes the days you want to carry over to the NIH side pot
- Enroll/Enter this side pot at www.NIHorse.com

The Open Horse Incentive

- \$1,000 Added with 10 entries – Less than 10 Entries \$500 Added
- Open to All Ages
- Open to all horses enrolled and /or eligible for any barrel horse stallion incentive.
- Example: If your horse is NOT eligible for the NON Incentive Horse, it qualifies for this incentive “The Open Horse”
- 1 Race over 3 days
- Must be entered in the Open classes the days you want to carry over to TOH incentive
- Enroll/Enter this side pot at www.NIHorse.com.
